Gear Recommendations: Use this list as a guideline for packing. If you do not have the exact brand or model listed but have something comparable from another brand, bring that. For more detailed info contact us for specific gear questions. We utilize and highly recommend you bring the best gear you can afford. Brands we recommend include: Stone Glacier, KUIU, Sitka, First Lite, Kryptek, Outdoor Research, Swarovski, Zeiss, Leupold, Vortex, Crispi, Schnees, La Sportiva, etc. We highly recommend shopping through Barney's Sports Chalet in Anchorage, AK for your hunting gear needs. They have most all the gear on our list and especially a few specific items only found through them.

Bedding: Please bring your own sleeping bag, pad and pillow, as recommended above. We provide cots for spike camps. While staying at Base Camp, we provide all bedding and sleeping gear: pillows, pads/mattresses, sleeping bags, towels, to remain in the cabins.

Firearms: Your rifle should be a light weight bolt action, scoped with good quality optics and dialed in 1.5 inches high at 100 yards. You should be adept at hitting targets out to 200 yards. If you handload, be sure all your ammo will chamber and eject properly. Practice as much as possible in all shooting positions. Silhouettes are especially good practice. Be sure scope mounts and all screws are checked for tightness. A good sling is worth its weight in gold. We recommend the heavier .30 caliber magnums or larger for these inland bruins. Example: .300 Win. Mag. .300 RUM, .338 Win Mag, .375 H&H, .375 Ruger etc. Quality bullets are crucial and sometimes more important than the caliber in most cases. NO BERGER BULLETS! They do not perform well on bears. Barnes TSX and Swift A-frame bullets are preferred.
